## Seeds of Doubt: Fear | John 6:16-21

1. Fear can and will lead to \_\_\_\_\_. (John 6:16-19; Matthew 14:28-31)

2. Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ can dispel \_\_\_\_\_ and restore \_\_\_\_\_.  
(John 6:20-21)

<sup>16</sup> When evening came, His disciples went down to the sea, <sup>17</sup> got into a boat, and started across the sea to Capernaum. It was now dark, and Jesus had not yet come to them. <sup>18</sup> The sea became rough because a strong wind was blowing. <sup>19</sup> When they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus walking on the sea and coming near the boat, and they were frightened. <sup>20</sup> But He said to them, "It is I; do not be afraid." <sup>21</sup> Then they were glad to take Him into the boat, and immediately the boat was at the land to which they were going.

<sup>28</sup> And Peter answered Him, "Lord, if it is You, command me to come to You on the water."  
<sup>29</sup> He said, "Come." So Peter got out of the boat and walked on the water and came to Jesus.  
<sup>30</sup> But when he saw the wind, he was afraid, and beginning to sink he cried out, "Lord, save me."  
<sup>31</sup> Jesus immediately reached out His hand and took hold of him, saying to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?"
